Dance competitors will receive a one-day entry ticket at registration the morning of the competition. Competitors and parents do not need entrance tickets to the dance competition, but a ticket will be required to enter the Celtic Festival.

## Competition Rules

- Competition will be governed by SOBHD and FUSTA rules.
- All dancers must have a valid FUSTA or Scotdance registration number to enter. A valid 2017 card is required to receive awards. If a dancer's card is not pre-sent at registration, a copy of your card must be sent to the organizer, and the National Registrar must be notified within 10 days of the competition date.
- Photographs and videos can only be taken of **your** dancer unless permission is granted by a parent/guardian.
- Change in classification must be received by July 1, 2017.
- This is a non-refundable entry.
- Organizers reserve the right to cancel, split or combine, add events or makes changes within the SOBHD rules. Competitors will dance in reverse order of entry.
- All competitors are expected to comply with FUSTA Code of Ethics.
- Any dancer causing delay will forfeit entry in any event. Any attempt to approach a judge or piper on behalf of a competitor may result in disqualification.
- Dancers must be in competition dress to accept all awards.
- Decisions of the judge are final. Protests must be made in writing and submitted to the Executive Secretary with a fee of \$5.00 before the end of the competition. Fee will be returned if protest is sustained.
- All dances count toward aggregate trophies and is awarded to the dancer in their class and age category with the highest points.
- Pre-Premier dancers will receive medals for 1st through 6th places. Aggregate trophies will be awarded based on age group and category.
- Premier age groups will be based on total number of registrations.
- Premier classes 12 and older will receive cash awards and medals. Under 12 age group will receive medals. Aggregate trophies are based on the number of dancers and age groups.
- Distribution of prize money in Premier 12 and older categories will be determined on breakdown of age groups.
- Competitor numbers will be issued at registration.
- DeRoia Hornpipe Trophy (sponsored by Judy Guernsey-DeRoia). Perpetual and keeper trophies awarded.
- Character Choreography Trophy (sponsored by Bassler Family). Music must be provided on CD or mp3.

## **Rule #1**

Illegal parking at Foxglenn Park is a continuing problem for NACHS. Because of the limited parking available and because we are required by the City of Flagstaff to provide handicap parking along with our own parking permits for vendors and managers, all vehicles not displaying a proper parking pass for the weekend will be subject to being towed. Please be respectful of NACHS and others by arriving early, parking in the proper place and taking the shuttle to the front gate. If you need to drop off items you may ask the parking officers for a drop off pass. They will take down your license plate and note the time, and give you 20 minutes to drop your things. After that time, you must remove your car and return the pass as you leave. If your vehicle stays more than 20 minutes you will be subject to being towed. We appreciate your compliance with this as we have had to make more stringent rules because there are always people who think the rules do not apply to them.

## **Rule #2**

Personal Liability Guarantee (Must be signed to complete your application) Foxglenn Park utilizes an extensive and expensive underground irrigation system. The use of stakes is limited to stakes no longer than 7 inches. We frequently experience gusty winds so you must weigh your tent down! Enforcement of this rule must be rigorously enforced by NACHS and the City of Flagstaff. Our continued use of City of Flagstaff property is dependent on adherence to this rule. Anyone (individual, group, organization, or similar) found using stakes longer than 7 inches long in their area during the festival will be fined \$100.
