

2009 REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Earlier this year the SOBHD implemented the use of the Temporary Registration Cards for Pre-Premier Dancers moving into the next category. This has been used by very successfully by Scotdance Canada. The SOBHD decided that dancers worldwide could benefit from the use of this Temporary Card. Dancers competing at a competition and completing their category could compete the next day or next weekend by using their Temporary Card. In the past they would not have been able to compete without their card if it had been sent to the Registrar for the upgrade.

Organizers, please print these cards out for use at your Highland Dancing event. Those dancers who plan to compete within 14 days after completing their Pre Premier category must use the Temporary Card.

TEMPORARY CARDS

Primary dancers should present their Primary card to the Competition Organizer who will issue a Temporary Card after competing in the last competition for which the card is valid .

Beginner dancers who complete their category at a competition should present their Beginner card to the Competition Organizer at their last competition, who will fill in the dancer's details on the Temporary Card.

Novice dancers advancing to Intermediate should present their Novice card to the Organizer at their first Intermediate competition, where they will receive a dated Temporary Card.

An Intermediate Dancer needing a Temporary Card in order to compete as a Premier within 14 days of the dancer's last Intermediate competition should present the Intermediate Card to the Competition Organizer who will issue a Temporary Card.

The Dancer may use the Temporary Card for 14 days from the date of issue and must return the Temporary Card and their original card to their Regional Registrar along with the appropriate registration form, fee, and photograph.

Any stamp gained during the 14 days must be registered in one of the boxes on the Temporary Card.

Competition Organizers should keep a record of the temporary card issued and send the bottom section of the Temporary Card form to the Regional Registrar within 14 days from the day it was issued.
