

FUSTA SCHOLARSHIP 2019 HARRY FARRAR IV MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

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This scholarship provides assistance to a United States dancer who has met the eligibility requirements. The recipient must demonstrate a high level of participation and interest in the art of Highland Dance.

ELIGIBILITY: The Farrar Memorial Scholarship may be applied for by a current-year registered dancer who is either a high school senior or high school graduate preparing to enroll in the first year of education beyond high school. An applicant must be a U.S. resident who is a member in good standing of FUSTA **or** whose dance teacher is a FUSTA member in good standing. This scholarship may be won only once.

FINANCIAL: The recipient of the Farrar Memorial Scholarship will receive \$1500.00. Funds will be paid directly to the recipient for the purpose of further education.

CRITERIA: Each applicant must submit a completed application to the FUSTA Scholarship Chairman in <u>one</u> envelope. Incomplete applications or those postmarked after <u>April 1</u> of the current year will not be considered.

A completed application includes:

- 1. Page 2 of the FUSTA Scholarship form completed, signed, dated and with a page attached listing Awards/Honor and Interests/Extra Curricular Activities.
- 2. Three required letters of recommendation:
 - one from the applicant's Highland Dance teacher
 - one from a school teacher
 - one personal reference not from a member of the immediate family
- 3. High school transcript
- 4. An essay not to exceed 500 words. Applicant to select from one of three topics on page 3.
